The confidentiality of the medical information exchanged by healthcare professionals is a particularly sensitive issue. Patient confidentiality was notably strengthened by article L.110-4 of the Public Health Code dealing with the confidentiality of the medical information stored in information systems or transmitted electronically.

In the context of these regulations, and to meet healthcare professionals’ growing needs with respect to information sharing, Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux is launching **Secure Medical Mail[®]**.

This new offering provides users with completely secure information exchange by email. In addition, to the classic messaging functions, **Secure Medical Mail[®]**, uses the technical specifications of the “GIP CPS” healthcare professional smartcard authorities to ensure rigorous identification and authentication of correspondents and for data encryption.

This solution, which is awaiting GIP CPS certification, is available on its own or paired with CLM's medical software. In the latter case, users can access **Secure Medical Mail**[®] directly from patient files in order to transmit all or part of their consultations as well as other components of the file.

Secure Medical Mail[®] is very easy to install and comes with a step-by-step guide to get users started. It offers four levels of data exchange so that healthcare professionals can select their level of security:

- **Open:** acts like a regular email program.
- **Signed:** provides the addressee with authentication of the healthcare professional's ID.
- **Encrypted:** the message is encrypted. The addressee can decrypt and view the contents of the message only if he or she also has **Secure Medical Mail**[®] or another secure messaging program certified by GIP CPS.
- **Signed and encrypted:** authenticates the healthcare professional's ID and encrypts the message. The addressee can decrypt and view the contents of the message only if he or she also has **Secure Medical Mail**[®] or another secure messaging program certified by GIP CPS.

CLM has always worked alongside healthcare professionals and accompanied them in their daily practice by providing complete solutions and tailored services for both specialists and general practitioners, private practices, clinics, healthcare centers and networks.
